WHAT IS RIDESHARING?

RideSharing is all about finding smarter alternatives to driving alone. Instead of commuting solo, employees are encouraged to explore options such as carpooling, biking, walking, using public transit, or telecommuting. Each of these choices helps reduce your carbon footprint, ease traffic congestion, and improve air quality across Riverside County. Even small changes in how you commute can make a meaningful difference, and the Riverside County Human Resources Commuter Services Division is here to make getting started simple and accessible.

SIGN UP FOR THE RIDESHARE PROGRAM

Employees who continue their RideSharing efforts beyond April may be eligible for additional incentives that support long-term eco-friendly commuting habits. To qualify for RideShare Program incentives and benefits following the Earth Day April promotion, employees must first complete the registration process through the internal RideShare Program. Taking this first step ensures you are enrolled and able to take advantage of available resources and benefits.
