COUNTY REOPENING

MESSAGE FROM THE ASSISTANT CEO / HR DIRECTOR

On May 22, 2020, the California Department of Public Health approved the County's request to reopen more businesses, as part of the governor's accelerated phase two plan. In response, the County drafted a strategy to re-establish County services based on public health data, while simultaneously ensuring proper health and safety measures are in place for all employees and the public. Therefore, it has been determined that the County will re-open effective Monday, June 15, 2020.
