Kaiser On-the-Job® provides a patient-centered, physician-led approach to treating work-related injuries. Patients receiving care in our dedicated Occupational Health Centers have a Primary Treating Physician (PTP) leading all aspects of care. This includes the initial evaluation, determination and oversight of the treatment plan, and coordination of care throughout the entire course of treatment, including completion of the MMI report when applicable. Assignment of a treating physician and any subsequent evaluating or consulting physician will be based on the physician's specialty or recognized expertise in treating the particular injury or condition in question.

The PTP will facilitate any needed specialty referrals for the injured worker. In most instances, the Occupational Health PTP will remain the primary physician and the specialist will become the secondary physician. If timely specialty appointments cannot be secured within the Kaiser Permanente Medical Group, arrangements will be made with the claims administrator to identify another specialist within the MPN.
